

Supplementary Sailings Instructions

KSSS Olympic Class Regatta, course area B

Date: 30 September - 1 October 2023

Location: Saltsjöbaden

Classes: Europe Class, RS Aero 5, RS Aero 7

Organizer: Royal Swedish Yacht Club

1. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 1.1 The regatta office is located at KSSS Clubhouse in Saltsjöbaden. The Official Noticeboard is the web https://www.ksss.se/kappsegling/ksss-kappseglingar-2023/ksss-olympic-class-regatta2023/
- 1.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole next to the water close to Sjövillan.
- 1.3 When signal AP is hoisted ashore, replace "1 minute" in RRS with "minimum 60 minutes".
- 1.4 Flag D with orange course area flag with letter B together with a sound signal means "Warning signal will be given no earlier than 60 minutes after flag D is raised". Boats should NOT leave the harbour until this signal has been given. This this rule applies to all classes on the Course.
- 1.5 On the water, the race committee communicates with coaches, supporting persons etc on VHF radio channel 75.

- 2.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no start will be made after 15:00.
- 2.3 Number of races

5 races are planned for Europe Class.

6 races are planned for RS Aero 5, RS Aero 7

3 Marks

- 3.1 The rounding marks are red marks and red dronemark. The starting mark is a spar buoy with an orange flag. The finishing mark is a spar buoy with a blue flag.
- 3.2 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or move the finishing line) without signalling. This changes RRS 33 and AppS 10.1.

4 Time limits

- 4.1 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes.
- 4.2 The finishing window is 20 minutes.
- 4.3 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 45 minutes to sail.

5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

5.1 The courses

Course 1 (2 laps) is: Start-1-(4s,4b)-1-4b-Finish

Course 2 (3 laps) is: Start-1-(4s,4b) -1-(4s,4b)-1-4b-Finish

All marks are to be left to port, except 4s which shall be left to starboard.

The race committee will show the course to be sailed in the race together with the class flag before the warning signal, by showing signal flag "1" for Course 1 and signal flag "2" for Course 2 (extra lap) etc.

- 5.2 The Race Committee will not show the course as stated in AppS 7.1. This changes AppS 7.1
- 5.3 The class flags are:

Europe Class Flag E RS Aero 5 & 7 Flag F

5.4 The following start signals will be used, this changes RRS 26, AppS 9.1 and Race Signals "Preparatory Signals":

Before the warning signal the Race Committee will show, which class, which group, which course and which start rule (I, U or Black) that will apply for the coming start. These flags are lowered after each start.
