

Supplementary Sailings Instructions

KSSS Olympic Class Regatta, course area E Updated with 3 different courses!

Date: 30:e september - 1:e October 2023

Location: Saltsjöbaden

Classes: FoilClass 8, Formula Foil, Waszp, Moth

Organizer: Royal Swedish Yacht Club

1. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- The regatta office is located at KSSS Clubhouse in Saltsjöbaden. The Official Noticeboard is the web KSSS Olympic Class Regatta 2023 -KSSS
- 2. Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole next to the water close to Sjövillan.
- 3. When signal AP is hoisted ashore, replace "1 minute" in RRS with "minimum 20 minutes".
- 4. Flag D with orange course area flag with letter E together with a sound signal means "Warning signal will be given no earlier than 20 minutes after flag D is raised". Boats should NOT leave the harbour until this signal has been given. This this rule applies to all classes on the Course.
- 5. On the water, the race committee communicates with coaches, supporting persons etc on VHF radio channel 71.

- 2.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no start will be made after 15:00.
- 2.3 Number of races

16 races are planned for Foilclass 8 - Moth

3 Marks

3.1 The rounding marks are WHITE TETRA

The starting mark is a spar buoy with an orange flag.

The finishing mark is a spar buoy with a blue flag.

To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or move the finishing line) without signalling. This changes RRS 33 and AppS 10.1.

4 Time limits

- 4.1 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 25 minutes.
- 4.2 The finishing window is 10 minutes.
- 4.3 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 15 minutes to sail.

5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

5.1 The course Windward - Leeward

```
(2 laps) is: Start - 1 - (2a,2b) - 1 - (2A,2b) - PinEnd - Finish
(3 laps) is: Start - 1 - (2a,2b) - 1 - (2A,2b) - 1 - (2A,2b) - PinEnd - Finish
```

The course Slalom - Babord or Starboard (1 laps) is: Start - 1 - 2 - 3 - Finish

The race committee will show the course to be sailed in the race together with the class flag before the warning signal, by showing signal flag "1" for Course 1 (Winward-Leward) and signal flag "2" for Course Barbord and signal flag 3 for Course Starboard.

- 5.2 The Race Committee will not show the course as stated in AppS 7.1. This changes AppS 7.1
- 5.3 The class flags FoilClass 8, Waszp and Moth are:

- Classflag Waszp, Moth E (Blue, Red)

Classflag FoilClass 8, Formula Foil
 Windward - Leeward
 F (White, Red square)
 W (Blue, White, Red)

- Slalom S (White, Blue)
- 3 lap course T (Red, White, Blue)

5.4 The following start signals will be used, this changes RRS 26, AppS 9.1 and Race Signals "Preparatory Signals":

Before the warning signal the Race Committee will show, which class, which group, which course and which start rule (I, U or Black) that will apply for the coming start. These flags are lowered after each start.

5.5 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.
