

Sailing Instructions (SI)

SANDHAMNSREGATTAN 2024

Europa Cup and International Swedish Class Championship for Sk30 & International Swedish Championship and Skärgårdskryssarpokalen for A22

Dates: August 7 – 10, 2024

Location: Sandhamn, 59.28, 18.91

Class: Sk30 and A22

Organizing authority: KSSS

1. Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Changes to the Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board at <u>Sandhamnsregattan KSSS</u> before 09:00 on the day it will take effect.
- 2.2 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 20:00 on the day before it will take effect.
- 2.3 On water information from the organizer will be sent via VHF channel 73.
- 2.4 A Whatsupp group for sailors will be created and used for sharing information.

3. Signals made ashore

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole in front of the race office.
- 3.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in RRS Race Signals.

4. The start

4.1 Cours area will be identified before 09:00 on the day it take effect via the official notice board.

4.2 Wednesday August 7

13:00 Tune up race

Thursday August 8

11:30 Time for first warning signal, 3 races are scheduled.

Friday August 9

11:30 Time for first warning signal, 3 races are scheduled.

Saturday August 10

11:00 Time for first warning signal, 3 races are scheduled. 15:30 No warning signal will be given later.

Class flag for Sk30: O Class flag for A22: R

4.3 RRS 26 is changed as follows:

Minutes before the start	Visual signal	Sound signal	Means
5	Class flag, and U or black flag if applied.	One	Attention
3	Flags with numbers 3 2 1	One	Warning signal
2	Flags with numbers	One	Preparatory signal
1	Flag with number	One long	One minute
0	Flag with number 1, and other flags are removed	One	Starting signal

- 4.4 To alert boats that a new starting sequence is about to begin, the orange flag on the starting line will be displayed with a sound signal not less than five minutes before the attention signal.
- 4.5 A boat that does not start within **five** minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.


5. The course

- 5.1 The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel at the starboard end and the course side of the **yellow** port-end starting mark.
- 5.2 The diagram below shows the course, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side of which each mark is to be left.

The course is to be sailed Start – mark 1 – mark 1a – marks 4s/4b – mark 1 – mark 1a – finish. The rounding marks are red, and mark 1 and 1a are to be left to port.

If pennant three is displayed at the Attention signal, the course is to be sailed Start – mark 1 – mark 1a – marks 4s/4b – mark 1 – mark 1a – mark 4s/4b - mark 1 – mark 1a – finish. The rounding marks are red, and mark 1 and 1a are to be left to port.

One, or more, of the marks could be a robotic bouy.




- **5.3** The finishing line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on race committee vessel and the course side of the yellow finishing mark.
- 5.4 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 70 minutes for the first boat to complete.
- 5.5 The time limit for the first boat to sail the course is 100 minutes.
- 5.6 A boat that does not finish within 20 minutes after the first boat has finished, will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes RRS 35.

6. Protests and requests for hearings

- 6.1 Protests and requests for hearings shall be filed at the ONB, <u>Sandhamnsregattan - KSSS</u> under Jury.
- 6.2 The protest time limit will be found under TIME LIMIT at the ONB after the last boat finishes the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- 6.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses, including time and place for the hearing. Call for hearing may also be e-mailed to the parties.
